Advancement from Qualifying Competitions to OTSC:

Advancement to the Ontario Technological Skills Competition for any contest is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest. Competitors **must also achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon.

The following numbers of competitors from the Southern Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the 2008 Ontario Technological Skills Competition, taking place May 5<sup>th</sup> - May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008 in Waterloo:

- Small Powered Equipment – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- T.V. Video Production (Team of 2) – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Culinary Arts – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Internet – Web Page Design – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Welding – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Precision Machining – 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>
