

#SkillsAtHome Challenge Series Challenge #15: Tools Challenge

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Challenge—Your challenge is to create tools out of household items to fill your "dream job" toolbox! Challengers will be scored on how many tools they can create, their visual designs, and a small written answer describing what each tool is, what the tool is used for, and what your "dream job" is!

Challenge Materials

Below is a list of some examples of materials you can use to build your tools:

- Items from the recycle bin (tin cans, containers, boxes, etc.)
- Paper (newspaper, construction paper, printer paper, etc.)
- Cardboard
- Glue, tape, etc.

- String, wire, etc.
- Paper maché
- Playdough, putty, clay
- Popsicle sticks

Anything you can find - use your imagination and be creative!

Challenge Rules

- 1. Challengers must build at least one tool but will receive higher marks if there is more than 1 tool in the submission.
- 2. Tools can be built as big or small as you would like. Marks will be greater for those who make their tools look more realistic.
- 3. Write a short piece including names for each tool, what it does, and what job your dream skilled trade/tech job/career would be!
- 4. Once you are done, upload your submission to Twitter or TikTok. Follow and tag @SkillsOntario and use the hashtags #SkillsAtHome and #SkillsToolsChallenge.

Safety: If you are using a glue gun, be sure to have a parent/guardian to assist you and show you how to use it. Remember, it is very hot! Also use caution when handling sharp objects like scissors and have a parent/guardian supervise or assist when required.

Skilled Trades/Technologies: Machinist, Mechanic, Carpenter, Brick layer, Plumber, Electrician, Welder, Pipe Fitter, etc. (any trades that uses a tool!)
