How to Enter—Participants will need to:

- Design a pumpkin based on the categories above. (See our website for skilled trade related templates!).
- Carve or paint a pumpkin with the design (see below for further instructions for each technique).
- Take a photo of your completed pumpkin and post to Twitter. Be sure to tag @SkillsOntario and include the hashtags #SkillsAtHome AND #SpooktacularPumpkin to qualify! Remember to include your age in your post as we will award a prize in each age category!

Pumpkin carving Tips:

- Cut the top off the pumpkin and clean out the insides, place in bowl.
- Tape the stencil to the pumpkin (making sure pumpkin is dry) or draw your own design.
- Poke holes into pumpkin through stencil with toothpick to create a guide on the pumpkin, then peel off the stencil.
- Rub flour onto the pumpkin to fill the holes to better see the image.
- Carve out design.
- Light up with candle.

Pumpkin Painting Tips:

- Tape the stencil to the pumpkin (making sure pumpkin is dry) or draw your own design.
- Poke holes into pumpkin through stencil with toothpick to create a guide on the pumpkin, then peel off the stencil.
- Rub flour onto the pumpkin to fill the holes to better see the image.
- Paint design.

Equipment/Materials:

- Pumpkin
- Large Bowl
- Large Spoon/pumpkin scoop
- Knife/pumpkin carving tools
- Tape
- Stencil or your own design

- Marker/Pen
- Toothpicks
- Flour
- Candle & match/lighter
- Painting supplies (brushes, paint, water)
- Device with internet access for posting your creation to Twitter!
