Canada - Apprenticeship Completion Grant (ACG)	The Apprenticeship Completion Grant (ACG) is a one-time taxable cash grant lifetime amount of \$2,000 per person for registered apprentices who complete their apprenticeship training and obtain their journeyperson certification.
Canada - Apprenticeship Incentive Grant (AIG)	The <u>Apprenticeship Incentive Grant (AIG)</u> is a taxable cash grant of \$1,000 per year or level, for a lifetime maximum amount of \$2,000 per person.
Canadian Apprenticeship Loan	The Government of Canada offers apprentices registered in a Red Seal Trade apprenticeship program up to \$4,000 per period of technical training. You can get Canada Apprentice Loans for up to 5 periods of technical training. Your loan will be interest-free for up to 6 years as long as you are confirmed as being registered in a Red Seal Trade apprenticeship program. You do not have to make any loan payments as long as your loan is in interest-free status. * Must be paid back upon completion
