Opening:

- An opening describes what skill will be demonstrated and how it will be done.
- Why was this skill chosen?

Demonstration: (Was an actual skill demonstrated as opposed to being discussed or presented?)

- Demonstration of the skill as described in the competitor's introduction.
- Thoroughness, depth and degree of difficulty of the demonstration.
- Demonstration was completed in a logical step-by-step process.
- Use of materials and resources.

Explanations:

- Clearly explains each step of the demonstration.
- Uses and explains terminology appropriate to the demonstration.
- Uses diction and grammar appropriate to the demonstration.
- Establishes a rapport with the judges and the audience.
- Voice: tempo, pitch, projection.
- Uses body language appropriate to the demonstration.
- Conveys enthusiasm for the demonstration.

Closing:

- A clear and appropriate ending.
- Information on how the skill demonstrated would be used on a job.

Response to questions:

- Questions are reasonable; within the scope of the demonstration and the competitor's knowledge base.
- Competitor addresses questions confidently.
- Answers to questions are clear and straightforward.
- Questions might explore the competitor's career choices and the relevance of the demonstration thereto.
