Important Policies to Note for the 2012 Young Women’s Conferences

- The Young Women’s Conference is a benefit of affiliation with Skills Canada — Ontario. If your school is not affiliated, please contact us for more information.
- Our online registration opens Monday, February 13, 2012, and closes Monday, March 26, 2012. Further details will be mailed out and posted online in January.
- A school may send **up to 8 students and 1 supervisor at no cost** with a limit of **24 students per school board**.
 - * Additional teachers/supervisors may attend at a cost of \$25 each, space permitting.
 - * Once the registration deadline has passed on March 26, all remaining spaces will be open to affiliated schools/school boards that wish to register additional students.
 - * Once capacity is reached, further registrations will be placed on a waiting list in case of cancellations
 - * There will be no onsite registrations and unregistered students will not be permitted to attend.
- Registrations will be accepted on a **first come, first served** basis.
- We remind teachers to register early. It is advisable to call ahead to check availability of space. This event quickly reaches capacity!
- Schools are responsible for transportation to the Holiday Inn Kitchener and pick-up from RIM Park in Waterloo at the end of the day.
- Many volunteers commit their time and energy to make this conference a special day for young women to explore their career options. Students are expected to behave maturely and respectfully.
