

Activity 2: Build a Village

The village (city / town), including the buildings, are to be decorated to portray the name of the building (Barber, Butcher, Hotel) or Canadian history (name of an event from 1 July 1876 to present day) and have a minimum of two roads (named after a Prime Minister) and mounted on a single piece of bristol or foam board.

Items such as artificial grass, trees, fences, animals, carriages, trains and vehicles used as accessories will be allowed.

The teams <u>must prepare, in advance</u>, a short (5 minute) overview on what their village represents and identify three (3) trades that helped build the village.

Building plans


- Building models used can only be from the building plans provided
- Plans may be enlarged by 150%
- Printed in colour or black and white
- Painted or colour pencils maybe used to label or decorate
- Stickers and / or labels maybe used to label or decorate
- Building can be printed / made out of paper or card stock


Building plans provided:

 - b. Corner Store
 - c. House small
 - d. House large
- 3. Ben & Jerry's Victorian House
- 4. Craftown (must be downloaded and printed from www.canon.com/c-park (creative park)
 - a. Port
 - b. School
 - c. Shop
- 5. Whistlestop low buildings (3), barn and roof
- 6. Build your own house
- 7. Tall ship


15MM ACW BARN






Directions:

- 2. Cut out each building wall and roof along the edges.












