### Financial Supports for Apprenticeship Training (Regardless of Gender)

Grant	Amount
<b>Canada - <a href="#">Apprenticeship Completion Grant (ACG)</a></b>	The <a href="#">Apprenticeship Completion Grant (ACG)</a> is a one-time taxable cash grant lifetime amount of \$2,000 per person for registered apprentices who complete their apprenticeship training and obtain their journey person certification.
<b>Canada - <a href="#">Apprenticeship Incentive Grant (AIG)</a></b>	The <a href="#">Apprenticeship Incentive Grant (AIG)</a> is a taxable cash grant of \$1,000 per year or level, for a lifetime maximum amount of \$2,000 per person.
<b><a href="#">Canadian Apprenticeship Loan</a></b>	The Government of Canada offers apprentices registered in a <a href="#">Red Seal</a> Trade apprenticeship program up to \$4,000 per period of technical training. You can get Canada Apprentice Loans for up to 5 periods of technical training. Your loan will be interest-free for up to 6 years as long as you are confirmed as being registered in a <a href="#">Red Seal</a> Trade apprenticeship program. You do not have to make any loan payments as long as your loan is in interest-free status. * Must be paid back upon completion
<b><a href="#">Ontario - Tool Grant</a></b>	The amount of the grant depends on which trade sector you're apprenticing in. The grant amounts are as follows:
