

Virtual Camp Safety Checklist

Although participants will be briefed before each workshop on potential activity-specific safety hazards and measures, this list is intended to provide a general list of items to check within everyone's individual workspace. We highly encourage each participant completes this checklist before attended each virtual camp event. Participants should discuss with any items they are unable to check-off on the list with parent/guardian, to discuss how to minimize any risks identified.

FIRES	
Have all potential Fire Hazards been identified?	
Have all flammable substances been adequately controlled to minimize risk?	
Are proper fire extinguishers located close to event area?	
MEANS OF ESCAPE	
Are you aware of your closest evacuation route?	
Is the evacuation route unobstructed?	
SLIPS & TRIPS	
Have slip and trip hazards been identified and controlled?	
Are proper processes/equipment in place to deal with cleaning of spills?	
Are you wearing appropriate footwear to perform your tasks?	
Has congestion in your workspace space been minimized?	
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)	
Do you have the specialize PPE required for the task (if applicable)?	
Are you and everyone else assisting you wearing the appropriate PPE?	
Have you inspected your PPE for any defects?	
Does the PPE fit correctly?	
FIRST AID/EMERGENCIES	
Do you have a parent/guardian supervision?	
Do you have a plan for what to do if you require first aid?	
EQUIPMENT/MATERIALS	
Are you aware of the equipment hazards?	
Are you using the equipment safely (including long-hair tied back, and no loose clothing, is	
applicable)	_
Is all equipment safe for use?	
I have read all labels for my specific materials and understand how to handle them safely.
