## ADVANCEMENT FROM QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS TO SKILLS ONTARIO COMPETITION

Competitors at the Qualifying Competitions **must achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon and be considered for advancement.

The following numbers of competitors from the Northern Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the **2023 Skills Ontario Competition, taking place May 1-3, 2023** in Toronto:

- Carpentry – Individual – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Culinary Arts – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- T.V. Video Production (Team of 2) – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- Welding – 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>

### Advancement Policy

The competitors/teams with the three highest scores in each contest will advance to the Skills Ontario Competition, regardless of their school board representation, ie. if the top two scores are from the same school board, both will receive ribbons and advance. Each school board may request up to **TWO** (2) spaces per contest and both will be eligible to advance.

## DRIVING FROM COMMERCE COURT TO COLLEGE DRIVE

Driving distance: 7.8 km

Driving time: 11 minutes

Start at: 60 Commerce Crescent North Bay, ON

1. Head west on Commerce Crescent toward Seymour St - 0.4 km
2. Turn right at Seymour St - 0.8 km
3. Turn right at HWY-11 N/HWY-17 W
4. Continue to follow HWY-17 W - 5.0 km

5. Turn right at Gormanville Rd - 0.3 km

6. Turn left at College Dr - 1.3 km

Arrive at: College Dr North Bay, ON
