Background:

Emma and Fletcher are a newlywed couple starting a new business together. It is a combination of their two passions: coffee and classic board games. The couple wanted a place where people could be brought together and interact in a fun and engaging way without the use of cellphones.

Thus, Snacks & Lattes was born. The couple has already invested in a location and done all required renovations, now they are looking for the design elements needed in order to get their new business up and running by the end of June, 2019.

Project:

Emma and Fletcher have approached you to design their café's logo, a grand opening poster and a personalized classic board game box design that will be specific to their café!

Target Market: Men and women, ages 16-30

Required Elements:

Logo

- Must be created in Illustrator
- · Document size: 6"x6"
- Logo can contain a maximum of 3 colours
- Logo must contain at least one of the following Spot Colours:

Blue - Pantone 2985 C

Green - Pantone 359 C

Orange - Pantone 157 C

- Logo must contain the name of café and at least one graphic element (see image section for inspiration)
- · Logo must be modern & clean
- Target audience is men and women, ages 16-30
- Once logo is complete, you must use Photoshop to place your logo on to the supplied storefront image
- When complete, logo and storefront must be printed and all files must be saved in the final folder on your desktop named ""FirstNameLastName_Skills2019"

Board Game box

- Supplied text placed in requested locations
- Must be designed in Illustrator using supplied dieline. DO NOT RESIZE, MOVE, CHANGE OR ADJUST DIELINE IN ANYWAY UNLESS SPECIFIED.
- Design must be 4-Colour Process
- · Must include name of game
- A graphic element relating to the board game and eye-catching typography must be included
- Design must be original and not copied or taken from previous board game designs
- Snacks & Lattes logo must appear on front of box
- When complete, must be printed, cut and assembled and all files must be saved in the final folder on your desktop named "FirstNameLastName_Skills2019"

- 1 Photoshop file of digital poster, saved as .psd unflattened (must include all working layers)






