# Official Guidelines for the 2015 Colouring Book Contest by Ontario Council of Technology Education (OCTE) and Skills Ontario

- Contest open to Grade 7-8 and High School (9-12) students who attend a school affiliated with Skills Ontario
- **Submission Specifications:**
  - All drawings must be Line Art only (clear outlines like most colouring book images)
  - Created to fit on 8.5x11 sheet – 2 page drawings are acceptable (17x11)
  - All entries must include students name, school, teacher/advisor, course, grade, complete home mailing address and home phone number
- The image must be related to a Skilled Trade and contain a mix of a Tradesperson **and** Tools/Supplies. Examples of Skilled Trades are listed below, but any skilled trade careers are accepted
