Coming from the North (Kapuskasing, Timmins...)

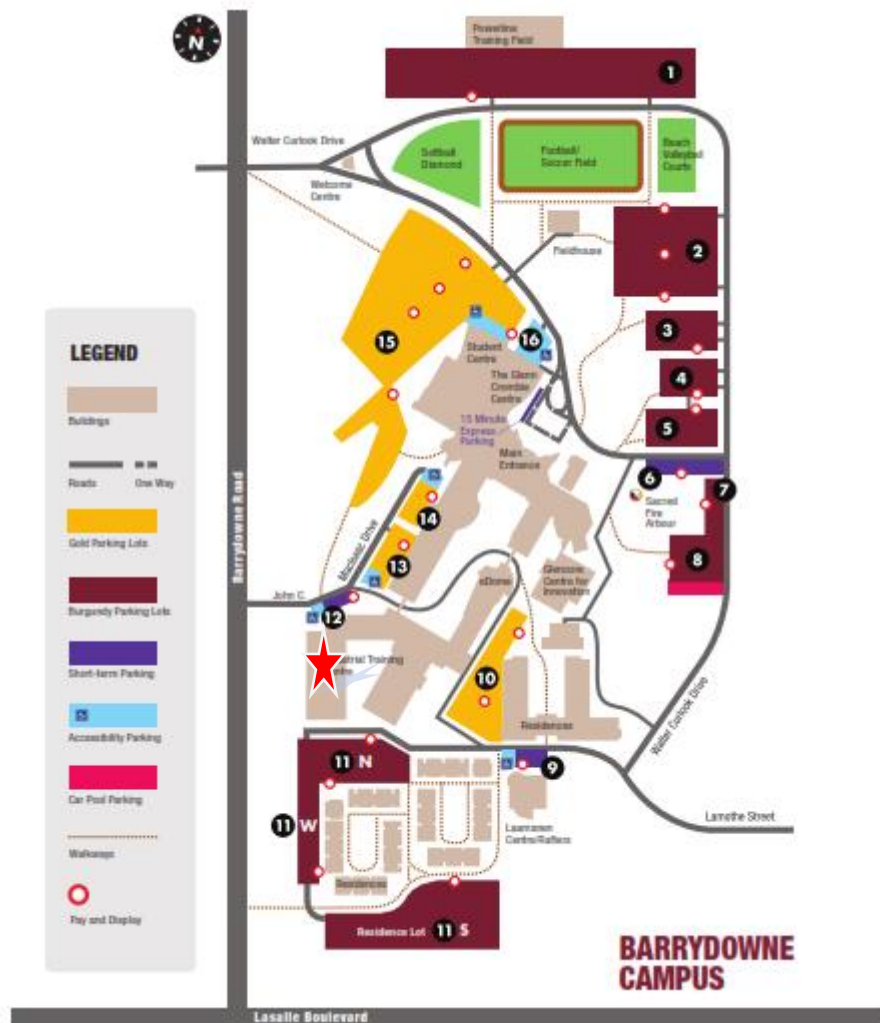
- Follow Hwy. 144 past Chelmsford and Azilda towards Sudbury
- Take the Lasalle Blvd. exit off of Hwy. 144
- Stay on Lasalle Blvd. until you reach the lights at Barrydowne Road (you'll see the New Sudbury Shopping Centre on your right)
- Turn left onto Barrydowne Road
- Turn right onto John MacIsaac Drive (NOTE: this is the first entrance on your right – TRADES AREA)

Coming from the East (Ottawa, Pembroke, North Bay...)

- Head West on Hwy. 17 towards Sudbury
- Turn right onto Barrydowne Road (next set of lights past the intersection of Falconbridge Hwy. and Second Avenue)
- Turn right at John MacIsaac Drive (NOTE: this is the first entrance on your right – TRADES AREA)

Coming from the West (Thunder Bay, Sault Ste-Marie, Blind River...)

- Follow Hwy. 17 to the lights at the intersection of Long Lake Road
- Turn left onto Long Lake Road (which turns into Paris Street)
- Continue on Paris Street to the lights at Brady Street
- Turn right onto Brady Street (which turns into the Kingsway)
- Turn left at the lights onto Barrydowne Road (you'll see Chapters and Costco on your right)
- Turn right at John MacIsaac Drive (past lights on Lasalle Boulevard)



Parking

Please use the John MacIsaac Drive entrance.

Parking is free on the weekends, but please park in lots 12 and 13.

The best entrance to use is right at lot 12, (★ marks the location entrance) look for Industrial Training Centre doors.

ADVANCEMENT FROM QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS TO OTSC

Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for any contest is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest. Competitors **must also achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon.

The following numbers of competitors from the Northern Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the 2017 Skills Ontario Competition, taking place May 1-3, 2017 in Toronto:

- Small Powered Equipment – 1st, 2nd and 3rd

NEW!! Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for all Qualifying Competition contests is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest at the event. After the event, **wildcard spaces will be allocated to the remainder of the top placing competitors/teams** regardless of location or existing school board representation.
