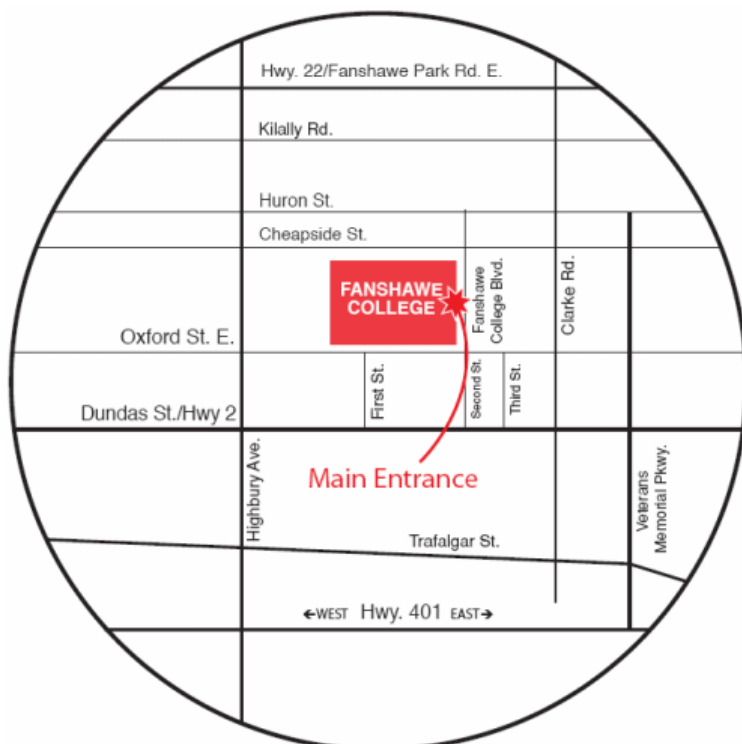

ADVANCEMENT FROM QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS TO SKILLS ONTARIO COMPETITION

Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for any contest is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest. Competitors **must also achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon.

The following numbers of competitors from the Western Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the 2017 Skills Ontario Competition, taking place May 1-3, 2017 in Toronto:

- 2D Computer Character Animation (Team of 2) – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Carpentry – Individual – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Culinary Arts – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Small Powered Equipment – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- T.V. Video Production (Team of 2) – 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Welding – 1st and 2nd and 3rd

NEW!! Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for all Qualifying Competition contests is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest at the event. After the event, **wildcard spaces will be allocated to the remainder of the top placing competitors/teams** regardless of location or existing school board representation.

- Across street from college: Sammy's Souvlaki (wide variety of sandwiches)

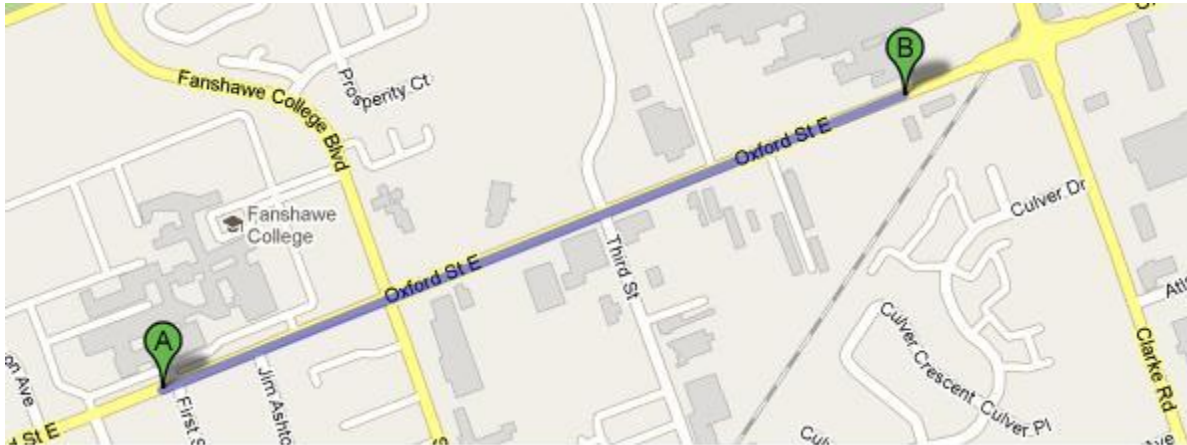
