#### DRIVING FROM COMMERCE COURT TO COLLEGE DRIVE

Driving distance: 7.8 km Driving time: 11 minutes

Start at: 60 Commerce Crescent North Bay, ON

- 1. Head west on Commerce Crescent toward Seymour St 0.4 km
- 2. Turn right at Seymour St 0.8 km
- 3. Turn right at HWY-11 N/HWY-17 W
- 4. Continue to follow HWY-17 W 5.0 km
- 5. Turn right at Gormanville Rd 0.3 km
- 6. Take roundabout to College Dr 1.3 km

Arrive at: College Dr North Bay, ON

#### ADVANCEMENT FROM QUALIFYING COMPETITIONS TO OTSC

Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for any contest is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest. Competitors **must also achieve a final score of at least 60%** to receive any ribbon.

The following numbers of competitors from the Northern Area Qualifying Competition are eligible to advance to the 2018 Skills Ontario Competition, taking place May 1-3, 2018 in Toronto:

- Carpentry Individual 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Culinary Arts 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>
- T.V. Video Production (Team of 2) 1st, 2nd and 3rd
- Welding 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>

**NEW!!** Advancement to the Skills Ontario Competition for all Qualifying Competition contests is limited to one ribbon winner per school board per contest at the event. After the event, **wildcard spaces will be allocated to the remainder of the top placing competitors/teams** regardless of location or existing school board representation.
